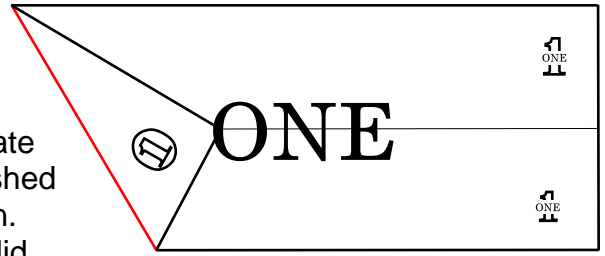
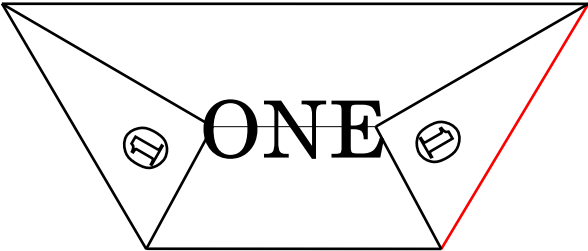


1) Mountain fold, unfold.

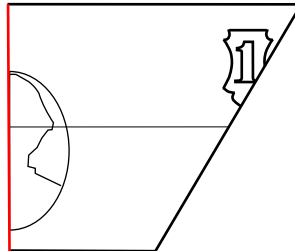
Red lines indicate a new fold. Dashed lines are hidden. Light weight solid is an old fold.



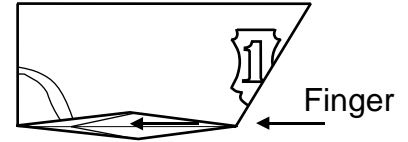
2) Fold the first wing



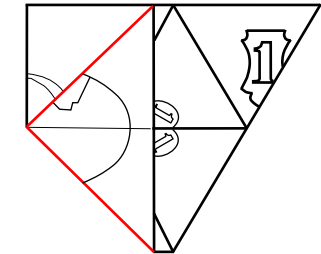
3) Fold the second wing



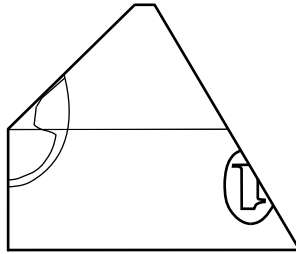
4) Fold in half, vertically



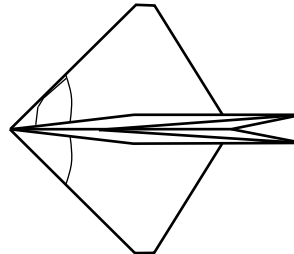
5) Stand the bottom flaps up. Slide your finger in to Separate the flaps.



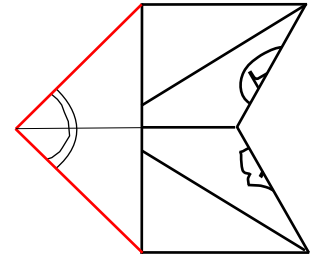
6) Flatten the vertical flaps out and down.



7) Flipped figure

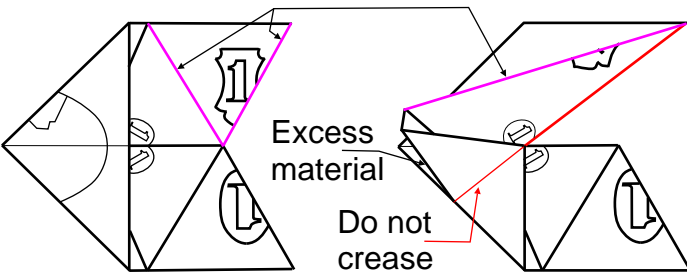


8) Stand the top flaps up



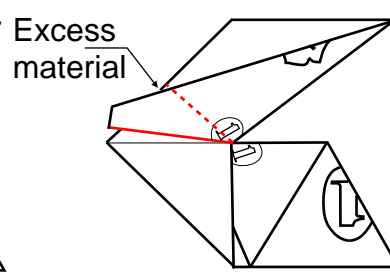
9) Fold the top flaps down

These lines become this line.

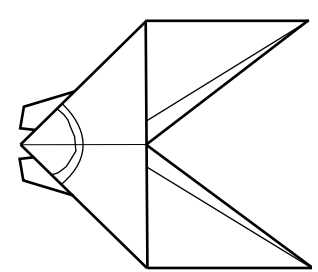


10) Flipped figure

11) Fold from the wing tip to the center of the butterfly - no further.

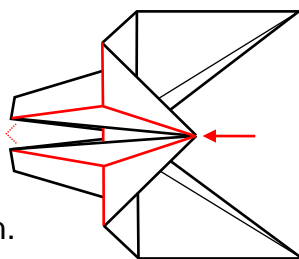


11a) Fold the excess material under the wing. The light red solid line goes to the dotted red.



12) Fold the other wing the same way, flip the figure.

13) The tip goes from the dotted position to the solid red point. The side folds almost fold themselves as you pull the tip to the position.
