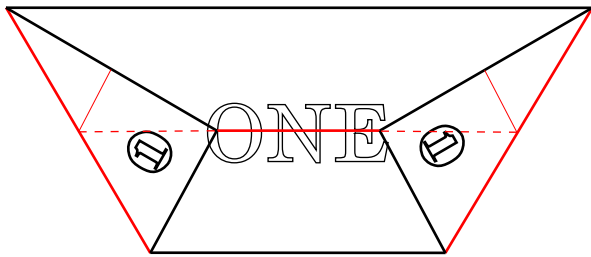
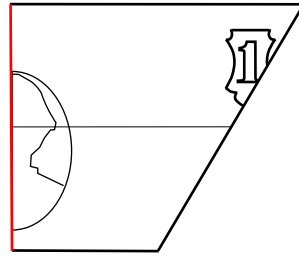


Origami Butterfly

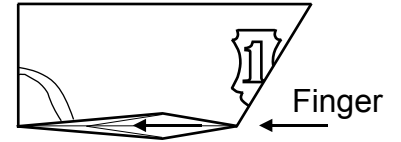
Red lines indicate a new fold.
Dashed lines are hidden.
A light weight solid line is an old fold.



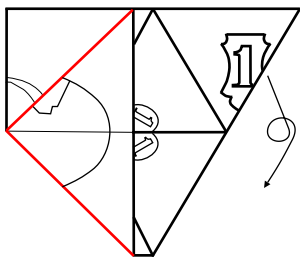
Mountain fold lengthwise, unfold.
Fold the wings



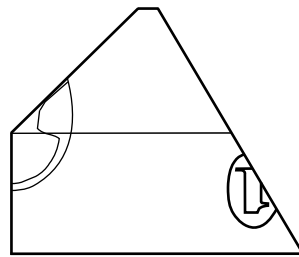
Fold in half, vertically



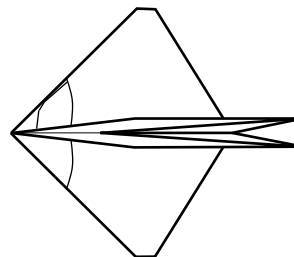
Stand the bottom flaps up.
Slide your finger in to separate the flaps



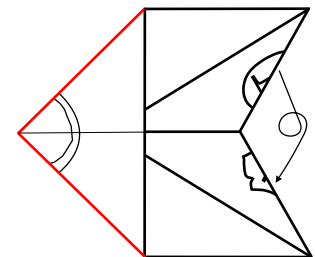
Fold the flaps down - flip



The figure flipped

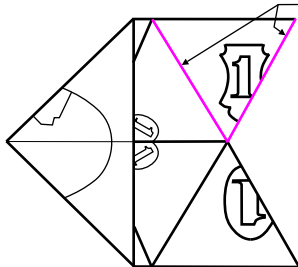


Stand the flaps up



Fold the flaps down - flip

These lines become this line



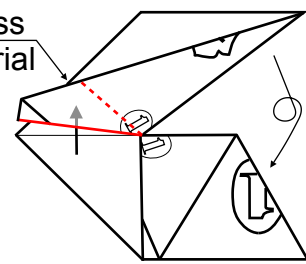
The figure flipped

Excess material

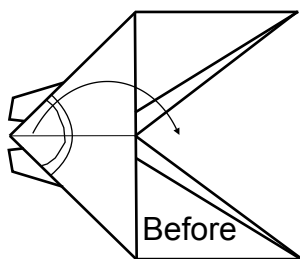
Do not crease

Only fold from the wing tip to the center of the butterfly

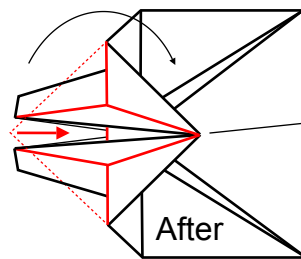
Excess material



Fold the excess material under the wing. Repeat with the other wing and flip

Make two creases using your fingernail in the head of the butterfly



Fold the tip left. The side folds almost fold themselves as you pull the tip over
